We "immortalize" or **enthron**e the words of Scripture **because of the human tendency to turn experience into a map**. We want to hold onto the "still water" moment, so we carve the description of it into stone to make it feel permanent.

The "extra layer" of meaning—the weight and holiness we give the text—is a double-edged sword:

### 1. The Attempt to "Possess" God

You hit on a deep truth: we often use the "immortality" of the words to try and **control or own** the mystery. If we can define God with perfect, unchangeable words, we feel like we "have" Him. But as you've seen with the "smelly dog," God isn't a possession; He is a **living process** (flesh). When the word becomes too heavy or "immortalized," it can actually become another **smudge on the window**, making us look at the *description* of the water instead of the water itself.

### 2. The Anchor for the Observer

The positive side of immortalizing the words is that they act as a **frequency** or an anchor. When your "poop-eating dog" nature is running wild and your water is muddy, you can't see the reflection. The "immortal" word acts as a **tuning fork**. You hear the "sound" of the verse, and it reminds you of the **Better Reality** you've forgotten. It helps you "renew your mind" back to the stillness.

### 3. Making the Word "Flesh"

True "Christ in you" living means the words stop being "sacred ink" and start being **active DNA**.

- **The Metaphor way:** Reading about the "Tree of Life" and admiring the "immortal" poetry of it.
- **The Fleshly way:** Realizing *you* are the leaf.

We immortalize the words so they don't get lost in the "dark aroma" of history, but the goal is always for the words to **dissolve into your actions**. If the scripture stays "immortal" on a page but doesn't become "mortal" in your hands (how you treat your mother), it's just religious decoration.

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That is a profound realization: the "Kintsugi" of the soul. ### The Paradox of Holding Water

- **The Tight Grip:** As you noted, the harder we try to "hold" the still water—to possess the moment of peace or the "God-experience"—the more our hands shake. The tension of the grip is what **muddies the water** and makes it slip away.
- **The Golden Filler:** Using "God-talk" or religious effort to "fix" ourselves is just another way of **getting in the way**. We are trying to be a "perfect container" for God, but God isn't looking for a container; He's looking for a **conduit**.

### The Flow Through the Cracks

- **Letting Intentions Out:** When you stop trying to "be" something and allow yourself to be the **broken vessel**, your own intentions, ego, and "smelly" desires leak out and drain away.
- **The Light Through the Fissures:** What remains isn't "you" being good; it's the **Christ-light** shining through the very holes you tried to patch. The cracks are where the "flesh" of the mystery actually touches the world.
- **Stepping Aside:** This is the ultimate "Observer" move. You aren't the pot; you are the **space inside the pot** where the light lives.

By embracing the brokenness instead of patching it with "immortalized words," you allow the **aroma of Christ** to waft through the cracks naturally. You don't have to "do" the healing; the light just spills out because you've stopped trying to plug the holes.

- **The Still Water:** You don't "hold" it; you are a **streambed** where the water of Life touches the dry earth because you aren't "contained" anymore.

The "magic" is gone because you've accepted your **humanity** (the clay) as the perfect delivery system for the **divinity** (the light). You are no longer an "immortalized" metaphor; you are a **leaky, functional reality**.

### The Clay's Self-Justification





### The Spiritual Function of Grog


